How to find us

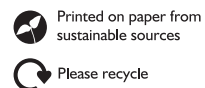


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Seaton Wetlands is located six miles west of Lyme Regis and eight miles east of Sidmouth, between Colyford and Seaton. In the middle of Colyford village on the A3052, take the Seaton road, signposted Axe Vale Static Caravan Park. After half a mile turn left into Seaton cemetery and continue through the cemetery car park to the Wetlands parking area.

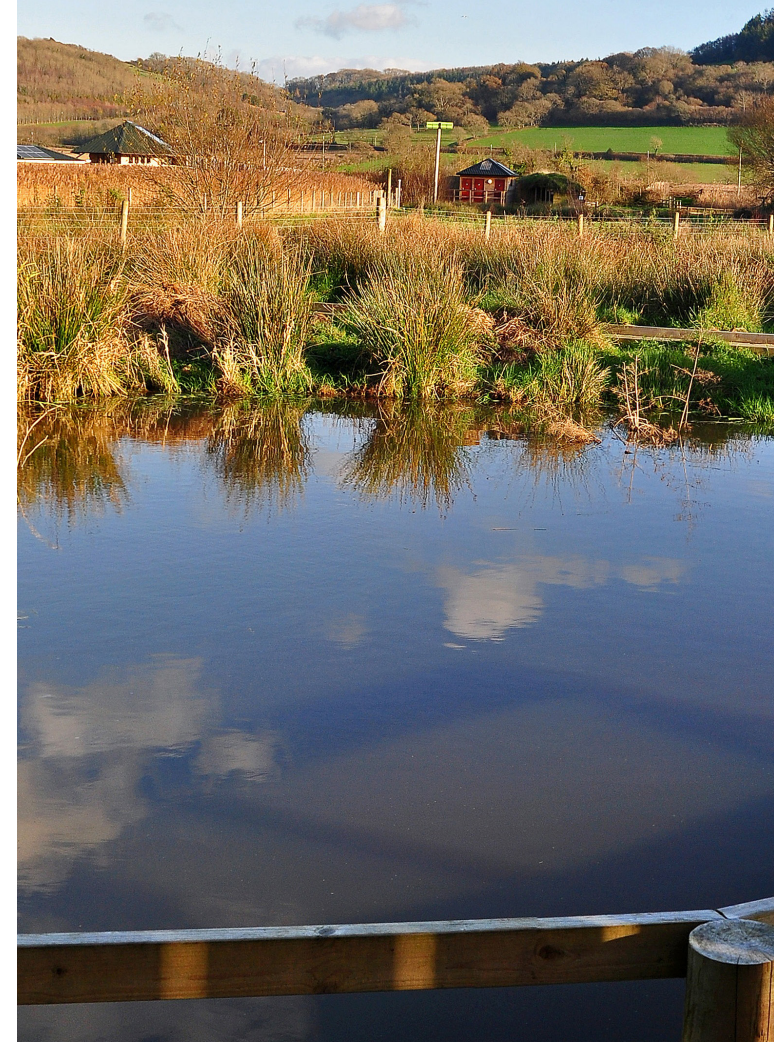

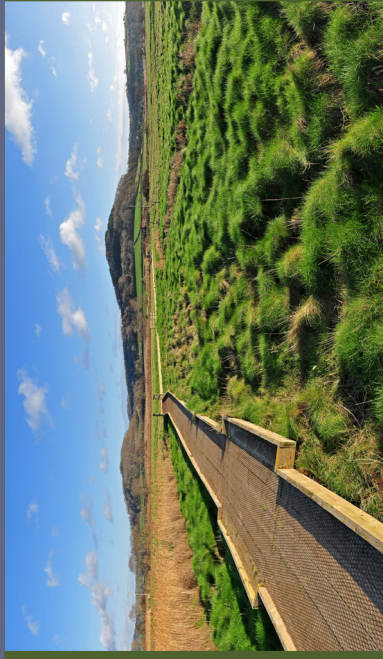

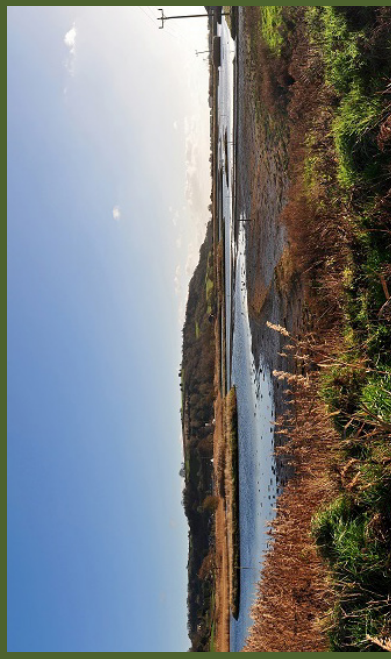
1 COLYFORD COMMON

Tidal salt marsh with broadwalk access to hide, viewing platform and circular reedbed walk.



2 STAFFORD MARSH

Ponds, reeds and the Stafford Brook make up the learning zone and wildlife garden. Toilet facilities also here.



3 BLACK HOLE MARSH

Intertidal saline lagoon with numerous islands and two bird hides offering 360° views over the lagoon and estuary.



4 SEATON MARSHES

Freshwater Borrow Pit with pond dipping facilities and hide with views over the Marshes and Axe Estuary.
